Visiting Boats by Water

For visiting boats coming by water, the Titles rules allow “fishing in” on the first day providing you have pre-registered your intent to do so. This means you may commence fishing, on your first day, as soon as you enter NBGFC waters. All other rules still apply including lines-in and lines-out times and deadlines for weighing-in.

Visiting Boats by Consort

As a Naming Sponsor of the Tournament, Consort Express Lines has offered to ship boats domestically, to Rabaul and back, free of charge. Boats are expected to be shipped end of February and early March. Consort will advise the intended shipping schedules in due
